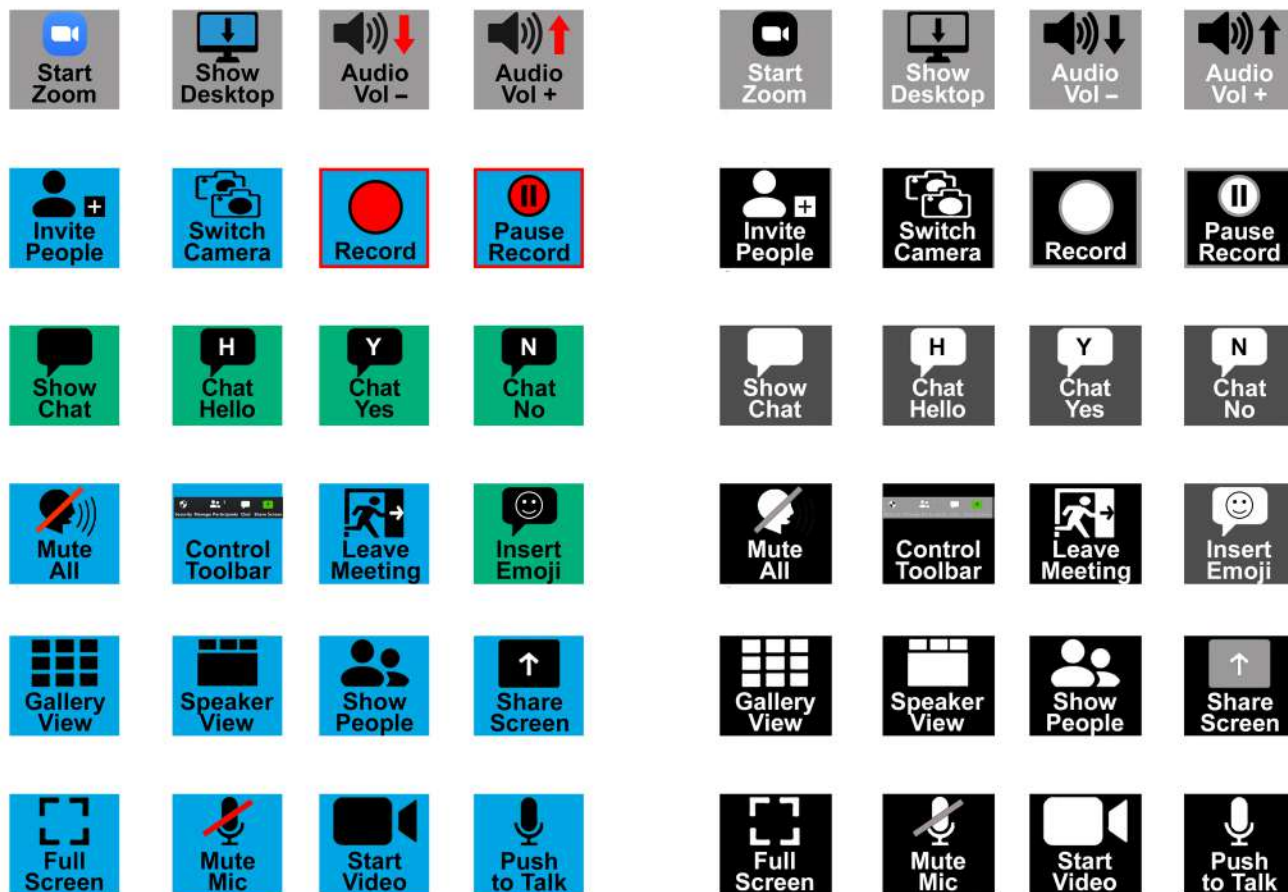


X-keys Video Conferencing Keypad for Zoom

Legends for Windows Host shortcut layout

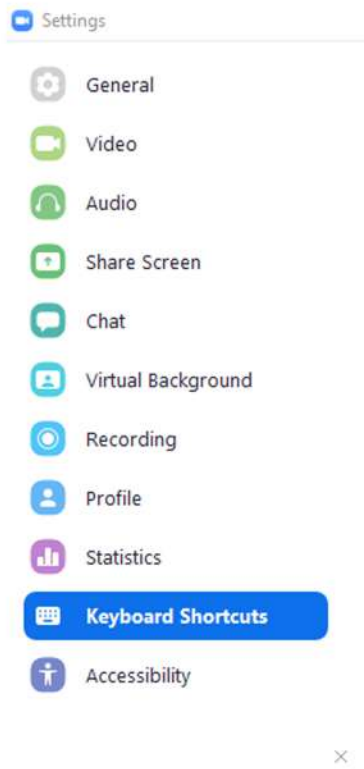
Print, cut out and install in the pattern shown to match the loaded shortcuts. Both color and black and white versions shown. Use the set that works best with your printer.





Instructions for Zoom on Windows PC:

- Download and install Zoom per their instructions (if you have not already done so)
- Using the X-keys Zoom Loader Utility (this program) make sure you have selected the **Zoom for Windows, Host** option
- Be sure your XK-24 X-keys is plugged in to the USB port.
- Click on the “**Load into X-keys**” button on the X-keys Zoom Loader Utility screen.

In Zoom:



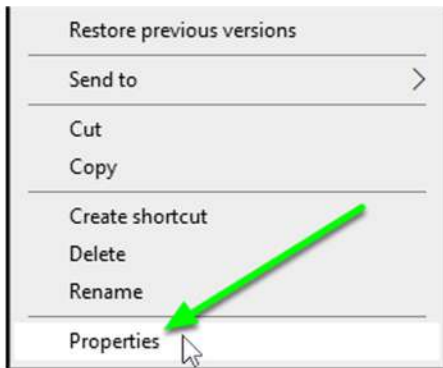
- Click on the gear icon in the upper right of the main screen. 
- From the list on the left, select the **“Keyboard Shortcuts”** option

Shortcut	Enable Global Shortcut 
F6	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/>
Ctrl+Alt+Shift	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/>
Page Up	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/>
Page Down	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/>

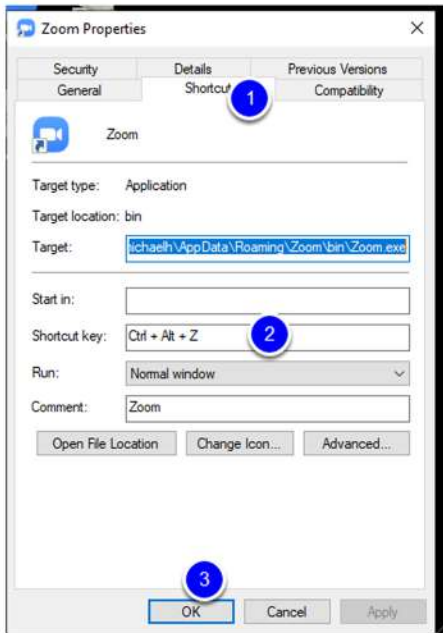
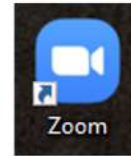
- Check off **“Enable Global Shortcuts”** for all options, to allow the keyboard and X-keys access to the shortcuts all the time when Zoom is running.
- Close the settings menu.

On the Windows Desktop:

To enable the Start Zoom button on the X-keys, you must assign a shortcut to the Windows Desktop Zoom Launch Icon. If not, the X-keys will work fine, except it cannot launch Zoom with the keypad.



- To assign a keyboard shortcut to this icon, Right click and select properties



- Select the shortcut tab (1)
- Click inside the Shortcut Key text box (2) and press and hold the Ctrl and Alt keys then press the Z key. The shortcut text box should show Ctrl + Alt + Z
- When finished press "OK" (3)
